Terms of Reference Launched July 2019

Background

The NNEdPro Global Center (NNEdPro) United States (USA) Regional Network was launched in July 2019 to further the mission of NNEdPro to facilitate sustainable improvements in nutrition and health behaviours in the United States. The US Regional Network is a collaboration of dietitians, doctors, educators, researchers, students, and health professionals.

Key Aims & Objectives

- ➤ Enabling knowledge exchange between the USA and IKANN (International Knowledge Application Network Hub in Nutrition);
- Advocating for the prioritisation of nutrition capacity building in the US healthcare system;
- ➤ Pilot the NNEdPro Mobile Teaching Kitchen (MTK) initiative for marginalised populations in the USA;
- > Implement and evaluate potential international models of nutrition education in the USA.

Purpose of the Steering Committee

The network's Steering Committee is primarily responsible for promoting research collaboration and facilitating network-related activities and projects, including funding applications, research and scientific outputs, and knowledge dissemination. Key responsibilities include –

- > Provide direction to the Network, including prioritizing tasks, searching for and following-up with opportunities, and developing collaborations.
- ➤ To identify new avenues for promotion of existing nutrition knowledge frameworks and research.
- Promote research collaborations which establish best practice in nutrition for health professionals.
