A Cambridge based dual approach to capacity building in clinical and public health nutrition

As the NNEdPro Global Centre now operates over a number of regions worldwide, promoting the translation of evidence-informed nutrition knowledge through education into practice, it is important to maintain a central annual hub for nutrition education and training. We endeavour to do this through our Cambridge based annual Nutrition Summer School and Summit in Nutrition Education & Research. The Summer School provides a 'Train the Trainees' platform that is internationally responsive to expressed need and adapted to our learnings from across global networks. The faculty from the Summer School are then joined by a number of other current and prospective faculty in Nutrition from across several countries for the Summit which takes a 'Train the Trainers' (including the trainers of the future!) approach to fine-tuning as well as up-scaling efforts to translate nutrition knowledge to those parts of the healthcare workforce not previously exposed to the discipline. Typically the Summit also allows consensus on healthcare nutrition education and research strategies across borders. With this two pronged approach and with widening participation, we hope to build a critical mass of both trained individuals as well as trainers, well equipped to face the triple burden of nutritional disorders (Over- and under-nutrition as well as micronutrient deficiencies) and the challenges set by the UN decade of action in Nutrition (2016-25) requiring both clinical and public health nutrition as well as a range of stakeholders to act in unison.
