

Prof. Caryl Nowson is a qualified dietitian, and she has a research program spanning more than 30 years that has focused on two major diseases of ageing: nutrition related to hypertension, and nutrition related to bone health.

She has conducted many community based nutrition interventions, some combined with exercise, assessing impact on cardiovascular risk, osteoporosis risk. More recently she has engaged in research and relating public health strategies to achieve population salt reduction.



Prof Suzanne Piscopo

Suzanne Piscopo is Head of the Department of Health, Physical Education and Consumer Studies in the Faculty of Education at the University of Malta. She is an Associate Professor in Nutrition, Family and Consumer Studies, mainly training BSc (Hons) Home Economics students, as well as providing initial education to future Secondary and Primary level teachers and early childhood educators. She is also an ad hoc lecturer with other faculties, a Board member of the Programme for Mediterranean Culinary Culture and a frequent guest speaker in school and community activities and on the mass media tackling subjects related to food, nutrition, health and consumption.


