AIM: To determine the blueprint for an International Knowledge Application Network in Nutrition over 2019-2025. This would include sectors and professions where capacity building is needed the most, particularly focusing on populations at greatest risk, methods of knowledge synthesis, delivery and impact evaluation as well as plans for sustainability.

From the Summit Chair

Welcome! We will begin with a review of previous Summits and setting out the purpose of the 2018 Summit.

The NNEdPro Global Centre plays a role in capacity building through its flagship training course, the Cambridge Summer School in Applied Human Nutrition. Candidates completing each successive Summer School are admitted to our International Academy of Nutrition Educators and typically attend the NNEdPro Summit. We will celebrate the success of the 2018 graduands as they are awarded their certificates of competence and become ambassadors for an envisioned 2025 International Knowledge Application Network in Nutrition.

Following the introductory sessions, delegates will break out into themed parallel round table discussions facilitated by NNEdPro Core Team Members. The NNEdPro Directors and Members of the Strategic Advisory Committee will meet in parallel, re-joining Summit delegates in the afternoon. The second half of the day will see presentations from each table and a synthesis of themes to form a joint strategic vision for the future.

An afternoon scientific mini-symposium will demonstrate the application of Nutrition knowledge from bench to bedside. Finally, Day-1 of the Summit will close with a decade in review, a forward look to 2025 and the NNEdPro 10th Anniversary Celebrations and 'official cake cutting' followed by drinks, canapés and networking.
